In 2010 youth events were held at the Notre Dame, Upper Humber, Gander and St. John's Rod and Gun Clubs. Conditions for parental supervision apply. In addition to the activities sponsored at each Skills Event, youth participants who are old enough to enroll in a Firearms Safety/Hunter Education Course will have their name entered for the Youth Hunting and Fishing Exchange Program and a chance to win an all-expenses paid trip to another province in Atlantic Canada to participate in a hunting or fishing excursion.
